



Procedures for Permit Parking for OVERSIZED VEHICLES and CARS in the Satellite Lot (Oversized Vehicles, Semi, Buses, RV, Campers, Trailers, Passenger Cars)

- 🍁 Permits are available on a self-serve basis, 24 hours a day, at the front entrance of the Town Hall building – 150 Ski Hill Rd.
- 🍁 Cost of permit: **\$5.00 per night, per each oversized vehicle, RV, unattached trailer, or passenger car.** Daytime parking is free. A car or truck with an attached trailer needs only one permit. Dropped trailers require their own permit.

NOTE: MAXIMUM PERIOD FOR OVERNIGHT PARKING IS 14 NIGHTS

- 🍁 Please complete **permit stub**. Pay for each **overnight**. Valid date is the day and time of departure.
 - ✓ The temporary parking permit must be completed in full.
 - ✓ Sign and date permit.
 - ✓ Bottom stub accompanies payment. Top portion **must be displayed** on the rear view mirror of the vehicle or attached to trailer. A local or cell phone number is **required** to contact you in case of any emergency.
 - ✓ Include payment and stub in the envelope provided and place in the **PARKING PAYMENT BOX**.
- 🍁 Lot is patrolled by the Breckenridge Police Department.
- 🍁 **Directions:** Follow Park Ave (Hwy 9) **NORTH** to Airport Road (Runs North out of City Market parking lot) Continue **NORTH** $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile to the **SATELLITE PARKING LOT**. Entrance is **EAST (on the right)** off Airport Road. There is a sign with a blue “P” and Satellite Lot with an arrow directing where you turn. Follow the drive all the way back to the parking lot. (If you reach All Electric Co. you have gone too far.) There are signs instructing you where to park your oversize vehicle.

Regulations for Permit Parking in the Satellite Lot

- 🍁 Permit is required in or on all vehicles after 5 PM. One permit per vehicle.
- 🍁 Permits are good only in the designated area of the lot.
- 🍁 No overnight camping or sleeping in the vehicle is permitted.
- 🍁 No animals may be unattended in the lot at any time.
- 🍁 Parking is available on a first come, first serve basis.
- 🍁 The lot is not to be used for long-term storage of private vehicles. There is a **14-day time limit** for consecutive overnight parking with a valid permit.
- 🍁 Acceptance of permit relieves the Town of Breckenridge of any responsibility for damages to or loss of vehicles, its contents or accessories.
