

Town of Breckenridge

Summary of Available Permits

Residential Permit

East

Purpose: Allows long-term renters and owner occupied residences who reside East of Main St with a Community Development approved need, to park in excess of 3 hours and overnight on French Street and overnight in the Klack Placer and French St Lots.

Criteria: Residents interested in obtaining Residential Permits must complete the application , get Community Development approval, , show a valid driver's license, & provide a document as proof of residence, *i.e.*; current deed, lease agreement, utility bill, vehicle registration.

Cost: \$25.00 annually (expires June 30th). A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacement permits.

West

Purpose: Allows long-term renters and owner occupied residences who reside West of Main St, with a Community Development approved need, to park in the East Sawmill and Wellington Lots without paying and overnight (Icehouse Lot available during posted snow removal).

Criteria: Residents interested in obtaining Residential Permits must complete the application , get Community Development approval, , show a valid driver's license, & provide a document as proof of residence, *i.e.*; current deed, lease agreement, utility bill, vehicle registration.

Cost: \$25.00 annually (expires June 30th). A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacement permits.

Temporary Guest

Purpose: Allows long-term renters and owner occupied residences who currently have a Residential Parking Permit (East or West) to purchase a permit for their guests to park in excess of 3 hours, without paying, and/or overnight in the same designated area.

Criteria: Residents or their guests who wish to obtain an permit must complete the permit stub, providing the vehicle owner's name, vehicle information (including license plate #) and local contact phone number.

Cost: Passenger Vehicles: \$5.00 per night. Oversized not permitted.

Parking District Employee Permit

Purpose: Created for employees who work within the Parking District to park in excess of 3 hours or without paying in designated areas. Exception applications are available for businesses that are not located within the parking district, but can show a need for the Employee Permit.

Criteria: Employee must complete an application, sign rules & regulations, provide verification of employment (form completed by employer or recent pay stub), & provide a Driver's License (or copy). Additionally, the number of permits issued to a business must correlate to the number of full-time equivalent employees reported on the BOLT License.

Cost: \$25.00 annually, prorated quarterly (expires June 30th). A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacement permits.

Overnight Employee Permit

Purpose: Created for bar and restaurant employees who work during the hours of 2:00am and to 6:00am. Otherwise, these individuals run the risk of being ticket during these hours because of the Town's ordinance "No Parking 2am to 6am on Town streets or in Town Lots".

Criteria: Employee or business owner must complete an application. The driver of the vehicle must be available for contact at the business noted on the front of permit, should the vehicle need to be moved.

Cost: The cost is \$25.00 permit (expires June 30th). A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacement permits.

Tiger Dredge Lot Employee Permit

Purpose: The Tiger Dredge Employee Permit was created to provide an affordable seasonal parking option for local Business Owners and their employees.

Criteria: Employee or business owner must complete an application. Business must have a valid business license with the town (permits issued per business are limited to the # of employees paid for on the BOLT license). Permit is valid only in the Tiger Dredge lot.

Cost: \$250 Fifty permits are available for purchase on a first-come, first-served basis. A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacement permits.

Lodging Shuttle Stop Permit

Purpose: to offer our guests a convenient, alternative method of transportation from hotel and resort locations to popular locations within the downtown business district. The stops also serve as a safe location to actively drop-off and pick-up guests.

Criteria: Shuttle providers wishing to take advantage of this program must apply for a permit and sign the rules page. One permit is required per vehicle using the shuttle stop locations. Vehicle information is required for the permit application. The permit is an annual permit and must be renewed every year.

Cost: The cost of the permit is \$25.00 per vehicle.

Lower Exchange Lot Permit

Purpose: New for the 09/10 season, this permit was created to take advantage of the covered parking available off the Lincoln street alley.

Criteria: Employees or business owners must complete an application. Business must have a valid town business license – permit is only valid in the Lower Exchange Lot.

Cost: \$500 – 20 permits are available on a first-come, first-served basis. There will be a \$5.00 charge for replacement permits.

Delivery Zone Permit

Purpose: Delivery Zone permits are issued to businesses allowing them utilization of designated Delivery Zones within the Town of Breckenridge.

Criteria: Business interested in obtaining a Delivery Zone permit must provide a valid business license, as well as current contact information.

Cost: \$ 25.00 annually (expires June 30th). A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacement permits.

Construction Permit

Purpose: Allows construction workers to be provided with on-street or alternative parking for the duration of a construction project. Permit applications are available in the Community Development / Building department or in the Parking Collections division of the Finance department in Town Hall.

Criteria: Employee or business owner must complete an application. Business must have a valid business license with the town (permits issued per business are limited to the # of employees paid for on the BOLT license). Application must be approved by the Parking department. Will be issued a general permit until need allows for a specific construction permit.

Cost: Assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Employee of the Month Permit (Friends Welcome)

Purpose: This permit is awarded to recipients of the Employee of the Month award from the Breckenridge Resort Chamber's Friends Welcome Program and allows them to park anywhere in the town for free and in excess of the 3-hour time restriction for thirty (30) days.

Criteria: Employees must provide letter, proving employee of the month, vehicle information, and current contact information.

Cost: No Cost. A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacement permits.

Patron Pass

Purpose: The Patron Parking Pass allows bars and restaurants to issue a parking pass to their customers, allowing them to park their vehicle in town lots, or on town streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am, without receiving a parking citation. However, the vehicle needs to be moved by 11:00am, or risks being cited. This is a single use, non-transferable, time restricted permit. This permit expires on the date and time set forth on the front of the permit. This permit is not intended for the use of establishment employees.

Criteria: Establishments interested in obtaining Patron Parking Pass Permits must complete an application, and permit stub must be completed at time of issue by the server (license plate # not required).

Cost: The Patron Parking Pass is offered free of charge to restaurants and bars as well as their customers.

Temporary Overnight Permit

Purpose: The Overnight Parking Permit was created to provide guests of the town safe and convenient overnight parking in the Ice Rink Lot. Camping is not permitted.

Criteria: Guests who wish to obtain an overnight parking permit must complete the permit stub, providing the vehicle owner's name, vehicle information (including license plate #) and local contact phone number.

Cost: Passenger Vehicles: \$5.00 per night. Oversized and vehicles with attached trailer: \$10.00 per night.

4 Hour Temporary Residential On-Street Parking Permit

Purpose: Allows residents to have a maximum of 5 guests' vehicles park on designated town streets near the resident's home for social events for up to four hours.

Criteria: Permits are available at www.townofbreckenridge.com. The permit must be printed out and clearly displayed on the driver's side dashboard. Parking is for short term, special events at the address only; drivers must be present in the address in case the vehicle needs to be moved. Only guests who do not reside at the residence may park on the street. Terms and conditions are explained in full on the website

Cost: No cost.

Residential On-Street Parking Permit

Purpose: Allows residents holding a special event to request on-street parking for their guests.

Criteria: Resident must complete an application to be reviewed by the Parking Department. The Parking department will phone the applicant to advise as to whether or not the application has been approved. Upon approval, the details will be placed in the "Updates Binder" at the police department. No physical permit is issued.

Cost: To be assessed on an individual basis.
