

## **2010 Kingdom Days Outhouse Race Rules**

### **OUTHOUSE STRUCTURE RULES:**

- Outhouses may be built of any solid material. The frame can be as light as cardboard or as heavy as plywood. No weight requirement.
- Outhouses should have four sides, a roof and a doorway. A door is optional. If teams choose to have a door, it must be secured open during the race.
- Windows are allowed but no glass may be used.
- Any number and size of wheels may be used.
- Bicycle parts and parts and pieces permitted. No in-tack bicycles.
- Outhouses must be at least four feet from the floor to the highest point of the outhouse. The overall width of the outhouse should not exceed six feet; this includes pushing and pulling devices.
- You must push or pull your entry (no motors or pedals allowed). Any device for pushing or pulling the outhouse may be used and must be secured solid to the outhouse.
- Each outhouse must have a seat with a hole that one team member sits on during the race. The seat must be securely attached to the outhouse.
- Each outhouse should have its name or theme displayed on the outhouse and a roll of toilet paper within the structure.

### **TEAM RULES:**

- Up to five people can be on each team. One person must ride inside the outhouse.
- A helmet is recommended for all team members. The team member riding in the outhouse must wear a helmet.
- The outhouse rider must be at least 13 years of age. There is no weight limit for the rider.
- A grasping device for the rider to hold on to is permitted.

### **THE RACE:**

- The race takes place on the 100 S. Block of Ridge St. (from the intersection of Lincoln to Washington).
- The race course will be divided into two lanes. No outhouse may go into another's lane. If a collision occurs, both teams will return to the start line and restart the race.

- Teams will race in heats of two. The winning team will advance to the next round and the losing team will be eliminated. (Teams will not be timed.)

### **HOW TO REGISTER:**

It is FREE to register.

### **SCHEDULE:**

1:00pm -1:30 p.m. – Outhouses should stage in the Exchange Parking Lot (on Ridge St. at the corner of Lincoln).

1:30-3:00 p.m. – People's Choice Voting will take place in the Parking Lot for the best themed and decorated outhouse. Winner receives \$100.

3:00 – 4:00 p.m. – Outhouses will race in heats of two from North to South (Lincoln to Washington intersections on Ridge St.) The winning outhouse in each round will advance to the next round.
