

#4 BLAIR WITCH TRAIL LOOP 3.3 MILES EASIEST



This is an easier mountain biking loop including a portion of the Colorado Trail and a twisty local favorite called Blair Witch. *Please avoid this area when wet.*

Directions:

- From the Horseshoe Gulch/Tiger Dredge Trailhead (2567 Tiger Road- 2.4 miles east on Tiger Road from CO Hwy 9), follow the clearly marked trail north through the dredge piles and across the Swan River
- Pass by a brown metal gate, then stay straight up the draw, crossing the Colorado Trail
- Continue uphill .9 miles (under the power lines) until a flat intersection with several spurs
- Turn left (uphill) and stay on the rolling and twisty Blair Witch Trail for 1.2 miles
- Blair Witch ends at a 'T' intersection with the Colorado Trail. Turn left, descend .9 miles and cross a two timber bridge
- Turn right just past the bridge and return to the trailhead



Distance: 3.3 Miles
