

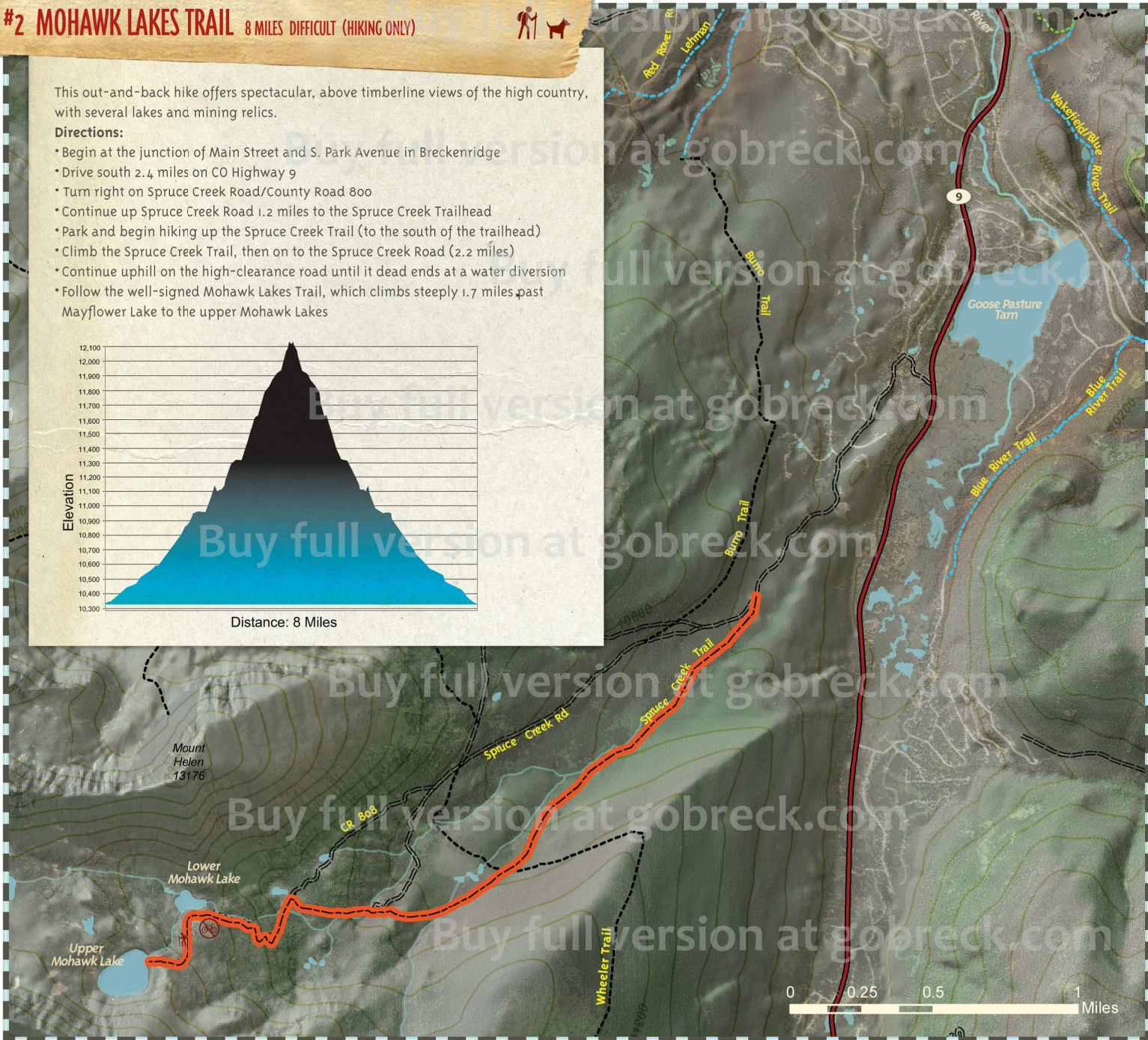
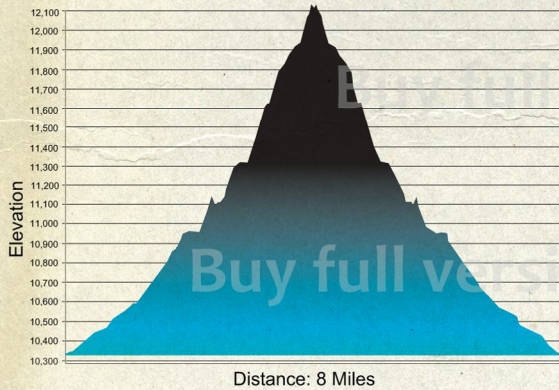
#2 MOHAWK LAKES TRAIL 8 MILES DIFFICULT (HIKING ONLY)



This out-and-back hike offers spectacular, above timberline views of the high country, with several lakes and mining relics.

Directions:

- Begin at the junction of Main Street and S. Park Avenue in Breckenridge
- Drive south 2.4 miles on CO Highway 9
- Turn right on Spruce Creek Road/County Road 800
- Continue up Spruce Creek Road 1.2 miles to the Spruce Creek Trailhead
- Park and begin hiking up the Spruce Creek Trail (to the south of the trailhead)
- Climb the Spruce Creek Trail, then on to the Spruce Creek Road (2.2 miles)
- Continue uphill on the high-clearance road until it dead ends at a water diversion
- Follow the well-signed Mohawk Lakes Trail, which climbs steeply 1.7 miles past Mayflower Lake to the upper Mohawk Lakes
