BUSINESS/EMPLOYEE FAQs

1. **What is this race?** Colorado Classic is a 4-stage professional (UCI-sanctioned 2.HC) race attracting many of the top cyclists in the world on August 10 - 13.
2. **When is the race?** Breckenridge and Summit County are hosting Stage 2 on Friday, August 11 for both Men's and Women's races on a circuit route.
3. **Where are the routes? Road Impacts?** Please see the maps and road impacts list. *NOTE:* New this year - In addition to the iconic Moonstone climb, this year the route encompasses Gold Flake Terrace, Pine St., Boreas Pass Rd. and Illinois Gulch Rd.
4. **When will the biggest impacts occur?** Thursday, 8/10 beginning at 5:30 p.m. when Main Street from Ski Hill Rd./Lincoln to Adams Ave. closes; Friday, 8/11 from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. all roads on the course will be closed making movement inside the circuit route difficult, so plan ahead. Please encourage your staff to allow plenty of extra time to arrive for their shifts. *Highway 9/Park Ave. remains OPEN.*
5. **Where can employees park?** On 8/11, the most convenient parking will be at the Satellite lot which will be serviced with frequent Free Ride service; most public downtown parking will be used for the race. If at all possible, bicycle riding and walking are encouraged. Limited parking may be available in French Street and Klack Placer lots; HOWEVER, it is cautioned that, even if a spot is found in these lots, there may NOT be an opportunity prior to 5 p.m. to leave the lot. There will also be limited parking in F-Lot. Please review the Street & Lot Impacts Plan.
6. **What about deliveries?** Please share the Delivery Information with your delivery drivers so that they can adjust their schedules appropriately. Deliveries on Friday, 8/11 will be very challenging. Please note that many of the alleys are being used for race functions. Deliveries to the Ice House lot will be possible Thursday, but will be tight to get in and out - use the alley.
7. **For the Boreas Pass area, what are the options?** The majority of the area will be closed 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. (see Street & Lot Impacts Plan). The Summit Stage will be running buses between the Women's and Men's races but the timing is dependent on the race schedule and cannot be guaranteed.

9. **What is the television coverage?** NBCSN (NBC Sports Network)'s live coverage is from 4:30-6:30 p.m. You can follow the race on the NBC-Gold app and the Colorado Classic app.
