DELIVERY INFORMATION

Thursday, August 10

- Tiger Dredge (aka Riverwalk Center) lot is closed starting at 6 a.m.
- Main Street from Ski Hill Rd./Lincoln to Adams Ave. closes at 5:30 p.m.
- Ice House lot closes at 5:30 p.m.

Friday, August 11

- River Walk alley deliveries – must be completed by 8 a.m.
- N. Main Street alley (100-200 N. Main Street) – deliveries must be completed by 8 a.m.
- S. Main Street alley (100 S. Main Street/Ice House lot) – box trucks can make deliveries in the alley until 8 a.m. Semi-trucks may park on the north side of Ski Hill Road just before the entrance to Town Hall in what is normally on-street parking until 8 a.m.
- Access to the east side of Main Street including Ridge Street and Ridge Street alley will be accessible via Ridge Street at S. Main Street – deliveries must be completed by 8 a.m.
- Hard closure of the course is at 9:30 a.m.
- **PARK AVENUE IS OPEN ALL DAY!**

FAQs:

1. **What is this race?** Colorado Classic is a 4-stage professional (UCI-sanctioned 2.HC) race attracting many of the top cyclists in the world.
2. **When is the race?** Colorado Classic is August 10 – 13; Breckenridge and Summit County are hosting Stage 2 on Friday, August 11 for both Men's and Women's races on a circuit route.
3. **Where are the routes? Road Impacts?** Please see the maps and road impacts list. *NOTE:* New this year - In addition to the iconic Moonstone climb, this year the route encompasses Gold Flake Terrace, Pine St., Boreas Pass Rd. and Illinois Gulch Road.
4. **When will the biggest impacts occur?** Thursday, 8/10 beginning at 5:30 p.m. when Main Street from Ski Hill Rd./Lincoln to Adams Ave. closes; Friday, 8/11 from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. all roads on the course will be closed making movement inside the circuit route difficult, so please plan ahead.
